

STANDARDS OF ARTICLE SUBMISSIONS

JOURNAL "RUSSIAN LANGUAGE ABROAD"

- Articles should be submitted to: rla@pushkin.institute
- The text should be in an MS Word doc-file (font: Times New Roman Cyr, 12 PT, after
- 1 interval, without hyphenation, aligned to the left). Margins: top and bottom 2 cm, left and right 2.5 cm.
- Paragraph indentation is set automatically (format ^ Paragraph ^ First line-indentation 1 cm). Attention! Do not indent paragraphs with multiple spaces and tabs.
- Page numbers are placed at the bottom, starting from the first page.
- To highlight the text it is allowed to use bold and italic writing, underline, and the use of any one color.
- Footnotes should be given in the end-to-end numerical numbering at the bottom of the page.
- Attention! The bibliography is given at the end of the article and is arranged in alphabetical order according to the following example.

- Bibliographic references in the text are made in square brackets [source number in the list: page numbers], for example, [2: 67-68].
- In the upper left corner the author's surname and initials are spelled out in Cyrillic and Latin letters, as well as e-mail, academic degree, position and place of work, city and country in Russian and English.
- Below, after 2 intervals, the title of the article is stated in Russian and English.
- The article is accompanied by a list of keywords (5 units) and summaries (500-700 characters with spaces) in Russian and English.
- The file is saved in doc format. File name — author's last name, for example, Ivanov.doc
- The photo is sent as a separate file in TIF or JPG format.
- Size: no less than 600x800 pixels or 55 mm x 65 mm at 300 dpi, provided that the face in the photo takes at least 2/3 of the area, i.e. the photo must be portrait. Scanned photos or photos inside doc-files aren't allowed.
- If the author does not send their photo, their article would not be accepted.
- It is desirable to attach illustrative material to the text (files in jpeg, gif, bmp format from 200 KB to 2 MB). Captions required!
- On the amount of materials.
- "Training section": up to 40 000 characters (10-15 pages), an introductory article to the training materials of at least 3500 characters indicating the audience for which the material is designed, and the level of their proficiency in Russian. The text of the training materials should not exclude the letter Ё.
- Articles on methodology, linguistics, literature, culture and other sections: up to 20 000 characters (8-10 pages).
- Articles in the section "Criticism and bibliography": up to 10 000 characters (3-5 pages). Bibliographic articles should include the cover of the reviewed book.
- Information about events (conferences, round tables, competitions, Olympiads, festivals, etc.), as well as relevant information about the activities of state, public, commercial organizations related to the teaching and distribution of the Russian language abroad:
- Category "Chronicles": up to 10 000 characters (3-5 pages) + photos;
- Under "News": up to 1500 characters (0.5 page) (1 message).
- Only original materials not previously published in other publications are accepted, unless otherwise agreed with the editors!
- The editors do not return the submitted manuscripts.
- All materials published in the journal "Russian language abroad", are protected by the Law of the Russian Federation on copyright and related rights.
